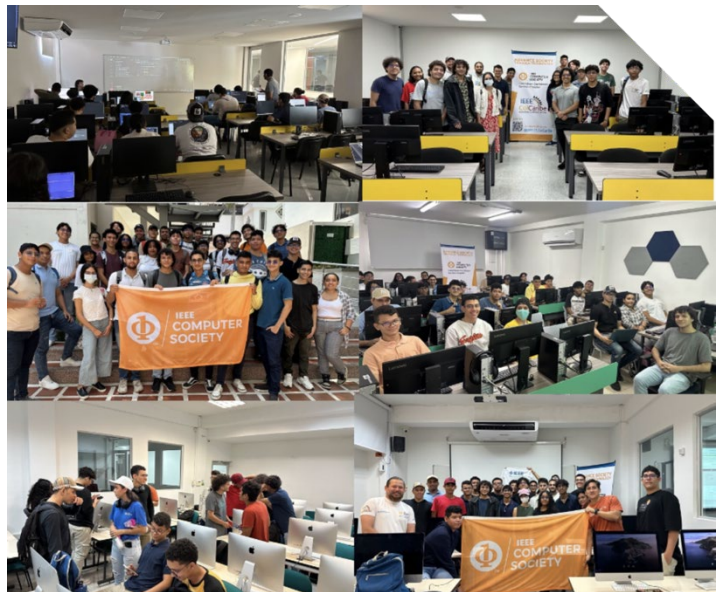
6 Recap all Chapters

Here's a quick recap of our exciting activities this May:

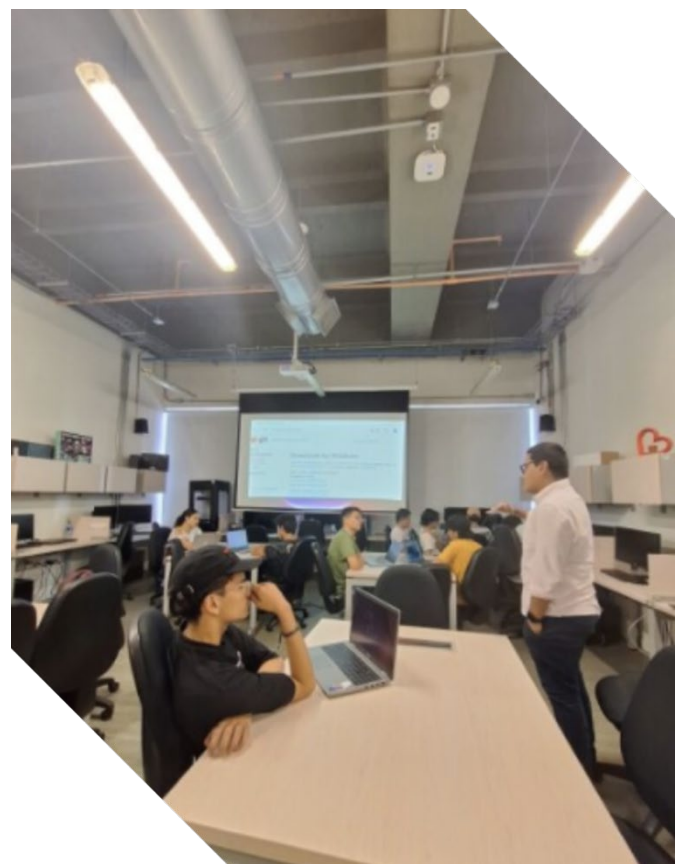
