

Richard E. Merwin Student Scholarship

The IEEE Computer Society is offering \$40,000 in scholar-ships to reward active student volunteers in IEEE Student Branches or IEEE Computer Society Student Branch Chapters. Scholarships, up to \$1,000, are available for students who demonstrate leadership and academic promise. Named in honor of Richard E. Merwin, past president of the IEEE Computer Society, the award also provides recipients the opportunity to serve as IEEE Computer Society Student Ambassadors for one year. Applications for the Fall Cycle are open from September 1 to September 30.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to undergrad and grad students in computer-related fields.
- Must be active IEEE Computer Society members for at least 3 months.
- > Undergrads must be in their final two years of study.
- > Minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 required.
- Must be full-time students with at least one year left in their degree or pursuing further study.
