



# Frequently Asked Questions - V1.0

## 1. What is the Regional Meeting?

According the IEEE R9 Operations Manual, Article IV - 2a, Regional Meeting (RM) is the annual gathering organized by IEEE Region 9, bringing together members of the Regional Committee, including the R9 Executive Committee (ExCom), Section Chairs, Council Chairs, and Operational Committee (OpCom) members. This meeting aims to address regional challenges, foster leadership development, and improve services for IEEE members in our region.

#### 2. What are the dates for the RM 2025?

**Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 8<sup>th</sup>, March 2025**. Depending on the meetings you are attending, you should program your arrival and departure dates.

## 4. When and how should I register?

Registration link is <a href="https://events.vtools.ieee.org/m/447717">https://events.vtools.ieee.org/m/447717</a>. The registration for the RM2025 must be completed before **February 15<sup>th</sup>**. The cost of the registration or Primary Delegate (PD) is \$0.00 USD. PD includes Section Chairs, Council Chairs and OpCom members. If you prefer a single room you can select this option for \$200.00.

Primary Delegates can bring a companion. The rate for the companion is \$450.00. This rate includes breakfast, lunch and dinner, and a companion program. The fee of the companion includes the companion's tourism activities.

If an additional representative from your Section, Council, or Committee, apart from the Primary Delegate (PD), wishes to attend the Regional Meeting (RM) 2025, they will be considered a Non-Primary Delegate. In this case, the Region will not cover any expenses related to their participation. The associated costs, including other fees, are detailed below:

## 5. Who will participate at the RM2025?

- All members of our Extended Regional Committee: Executive Committee, Standing Committees, AdHoc Committees, Section Chairs and Council Chairs.
- On independent economic sponsorship: Special IEEE guests, IEEE HQ staff.

## 6. If the Section Chair cannot attend the meeting, who can represent my Section?

The Section Primary Delegate is the Section Chair, and ONLY the Section Vice chair adequately registered in VTools can behave as Primary Delegate prior authorization issued by the Regional Director, Jenifer Castillo. Under special circumstances other representatives may be approved.

## 7. What expenses does Region 9 cover?





- Shared room (2 delegates per room), Welcome Dinner on Thursday, Host Program on Friday, Closing and Awards Dinner on Saturday, coffee breaks, breakfast, and lunch during your authorized meeting days.
- The air tickets are based on the maximum fare authorized by the Treasurer. The list with
  the maximum fares that will be covered by Region 9 has been provided to the members of
  the Regional Committee, Section Chairs and Council Chairs. If you paid the expenses with

## 8. How to buy the air tickets?

The primary delegate to the "RM2025" buys the air ticket selecting the most economical fare available. The R9 Treasurer will reimburse the cost of the air ticket based on the maximum fare provided via email. If the cost of the air ticket is greater than the cost indicated in the list, the difference will be paid by the delegate or his/her Section. IEEE R9 will only cover Economy Class Base fare tickets. Business Class tickets will not be reimbursed.

#### 9. How to get from Airport to Hotel venue?

Participants can take a Taxi/Uber for an approximate cost of \$6 to \$7. The transfer time from the Airport to the Hotel is 15 minutes.

- 2025 Current Officers Report. (http://officers.vtools.ieee.org/) before February 16th, 2025.
- **2025 Conflict of interest form.** You should have received an email from Ops Audit. Please check your email, and verify the due date, in some cases the requested date was for January 15, 2025.

Note: All newly elected Section and Council Chairs must have been elected in accordance with IEEE regulations.

What is the currency in Brazil? The currency of Brazil is the real (plural: reais), represented by the symbol R\$ and the currency code BRL. Reais are divided into centavos (1 real = 100 centavos)

Typically, March in Brasilia includes high temperatures and heavy rainfall. The daytime often sees temperatures reaching 29°C, but nighttime brings a cool-down to 19°C.

## 16. Is Brasilia a safe city?

Brasilia is one of the safest "cities" to walk around during the day, within the pilot plan and in all its functional divisions, where many people of all kinds gather. Avoid passing through here at night and early in the morning if possible.

#### 17. How to make a call?

To make a call to Brazil from abroad, you can dial the country code (+55), then the area code, and finally the local number.
